



Diane Loomer Choir Application and Program Guidelines

Applicants must read and agree to adhere to the terms as outlined in this document.

Purpose

If you're a high school choir conductor in Metro Vancouver looking to give your treble choir a morale boost within your music department, consider becoming Elektra's "Diane Loomer Choir". This is a free program, with the goal of bringing recognition to a choir within their school environment and the broader community. This process is not about identifying the "best" treble choir - it's about recognizing where Elektra's support would be impactful.

Note that Elektra has not previously offered this program to a choir outside of Metro Vancouver, but are open to considering this. Please write to us to start a conversation.

Deadline

The "Diane Loomer Choir" designation is for an entire school year, or a portion thereof, depending on the timing of us finding each other! Applications are open year round until a choir has been selected.

Eligibility

- This program is open to high school treble choirs in British Columbia
- The in-person program is available to choirs in Metro Vancouver
- The online version is available to BC choirs outside the Metro Vancouver area

As the "Diane Loomer Choir" conductor:

- you have an opportunity to meet with Morna privately, outside of the school schedule, to choose music and talk shop
- your choir will receive a free set of scores and a workshop(s) to learn the music and more during regularly-scheduled choir time
- you and your students have the opportunity to attend an Elektra rehearsal or concert (Elektra provides the tickets for up to 30 students and 2 adults for a regular-season Elektra concert)
- you receive an official certificate
